Quality & Safety/ Patient Engagement/ Impact on patient services:

First phase of implementation of the Primary Care Strategy – Network reconfiguration

The CCG engaged with stakeholders and residents in order that their views can inform the development of the Primary Care strategy to facilitate understanding of primary care within the borough and how an important first step in delivering the vision for accountable care and primary care at scale, was to reshape the previous GP Network structure.

17/18 Primary Care Investment Programme

The programme is centred on the principle of quality improvement through the development of the Quality, Service Improvement and Redesign programme and focus of delivery at a practice, locality, Primary Care Network level and borough level.

GP at Hand Practice

The CCG, NHSE and the practice will continue to work closely together to monitor and evaluate the impact of the proposed expansion and ensure it continues to deliver a real benefit for all patients.

Finance, resources and QIPP

17/18 Primary Care Investment Programme

The proposal was informed by discussions relating to QIPP opportunities for reducing non elective admissions for the over 60's; following analysis undertaken by an external consultancy company and the CCG Business Intelligence team.

GP at Hand Practice

- The CCG is working with NHS England to monitor the financial impact of the GP at Hand Practice. Further updates will be provided via the Primary Care Commissioning Committee.

First phase of implementation of the Primary Care Strategy – Network reconfiguration

Support will be available from the CCG and GP Federation to enable Practices to develop robust project proposals and to support delivery</p>
