Community Equipment Service

Like the Wheelchair Service, the Community Equipment Service provides free disability equipment to residents. Funded jointly by your Borough Council's Social Care and the NHS, they do not provide wheelchairs but can provide you with walking sticks, crutches, wheeled walkers, shoppers, walking frames and provide adaptations to your home, such as handrails and ramps. You will need to be referred by your GP to an Occupational Therapist who will review your needs and your environment and prescribe equipment. They will arrange for delivery to your home.

Pathway to alternative sources of wheelchairs

The Non-Eligible Care Pathway

Just because you are not eligible for a NHS wheelchair doesn't mean you are on your own. To us, it means you still have needs which can be met through other sources.

Our pathway for non-NHS support is designed to help you meet those needs and help you remain independent, socially included and able to manage your impairment, condition or disability.

The NHS doesn't provide wheelchairs or certain types of wheelchairs in certain circumstances. There is a published NHS Eligibility Criteria that the Wheelchair Service strictly adheres to. It sets out who gets what and why.

The non-eligible support pathway ensures a route to appeal the decision. Please contact Customer Services in the first instance and see our helpful complaints leaflet.

Help is at Hand

AJM's Health Liaison Officer, Rudi Breakwell-Bos (who is also a service user) is employed by AJM Healthcare to help service users, PAs, carers, parents and family to get the most out of your
